

The Abandoned Island: An Immersive Murder Mystery Experience. If your child already loves mystery themed novels and detective shows, then this class will give them the chance to test their critical thinking skills in hypothetical situations both based in fantasy and reality. Your child will learn how to excel in puzzles and riddles and find themselves using lateral thinking to be more creative in their guesses. The puzzles and riddles will involve colors, wordplay, shapes,

and elementary math. Students will look for misdirections, and break down the steps necessary to solve the puzzles. They will share and debate hypotheses with their classmates ultimately working together to solve the mysteries before class ends.



Wings of Fire Camp. Love all things having do with Wings of Fire? This 3 day camp will be led by teen and children's author, Jackson Pearce.




